

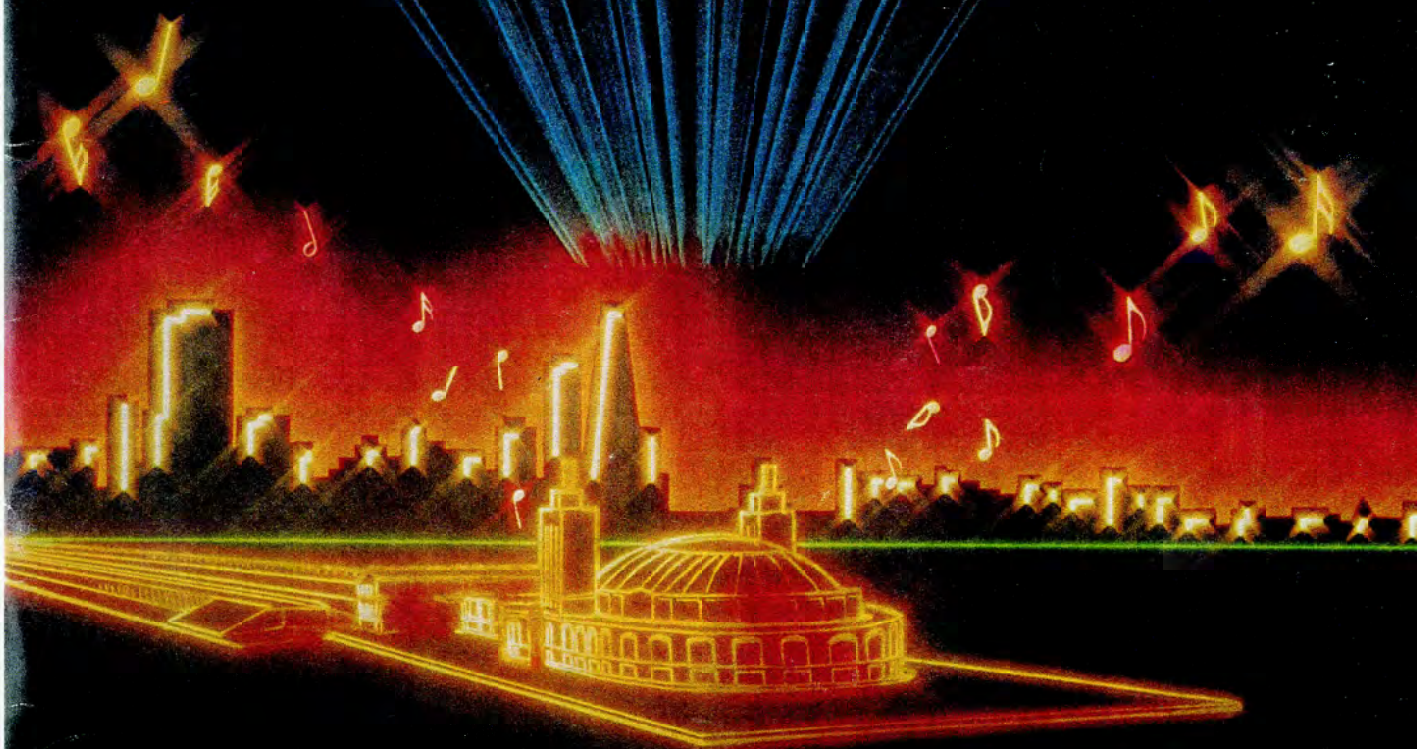

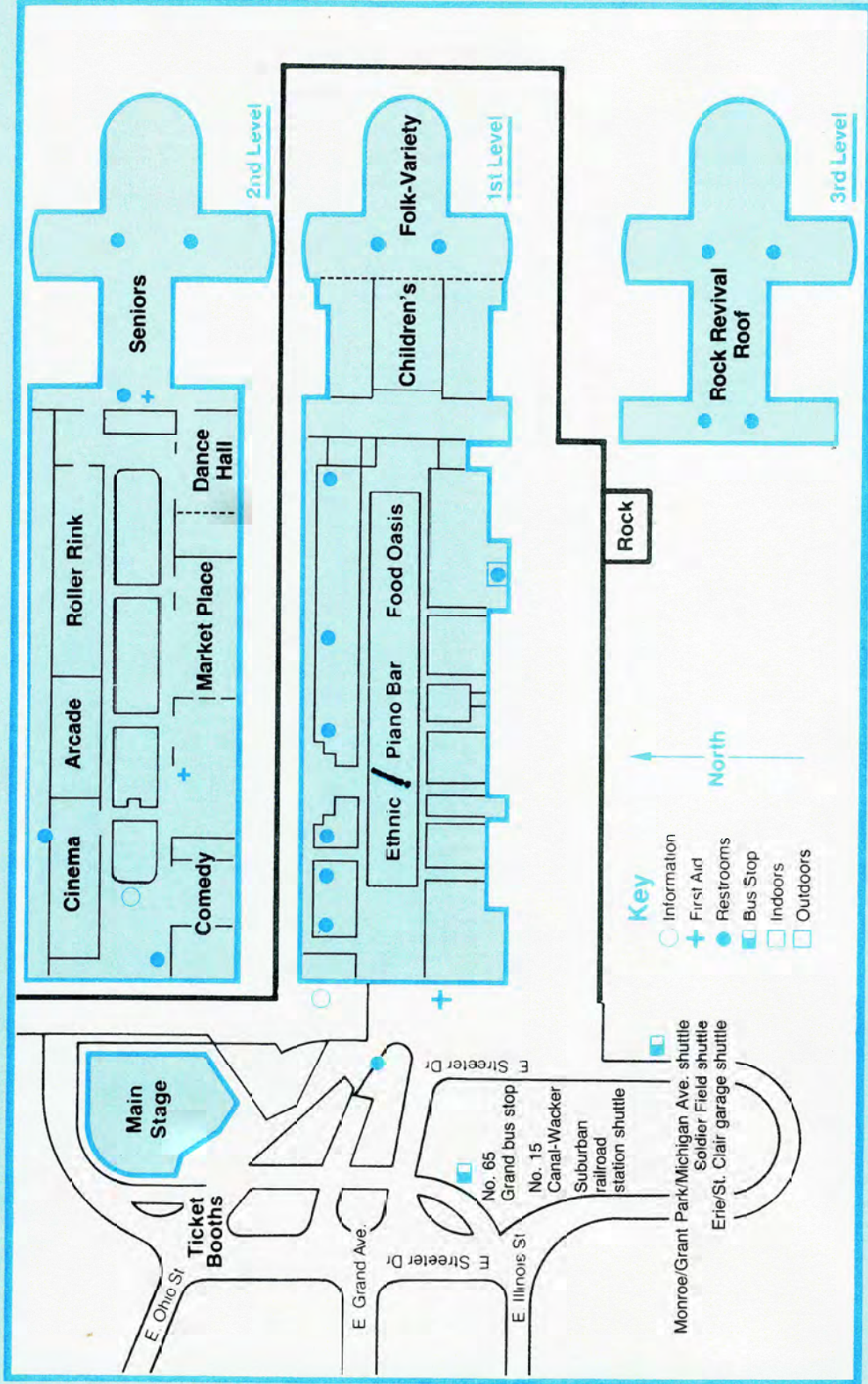

## ADMISSION

Ticket price for ChicagoFest is \$3.50 in advance or \$5 at the gate. Children 10 and under accompanied by a parent will be admitted free. Senior citizens may purchase tickets at the gate for \$1. Tickets are available only at city hall or by mail. The fest will run Aug. 1-10 and Aug. 13-17.

## FOOD

## SENIOR CITIZENS

A senior citizen area with free refreshments is being provided this year. It's located inside, is carpeted and cool and features ample seating. Special programs will be offered.

## MARKETPLACE

There will be an enclosed arts and crafts bazaar, with 100 booths featuring everything from jewelry to ChicagoFest souvenirs.

All restrooms are equipped for the handicapped and the entire pier is accessible to handicapped persons.

Put your car in park if you're thinking of going to ChicagoFest and leave it at home. There's simply no parking available at Navy Pier.

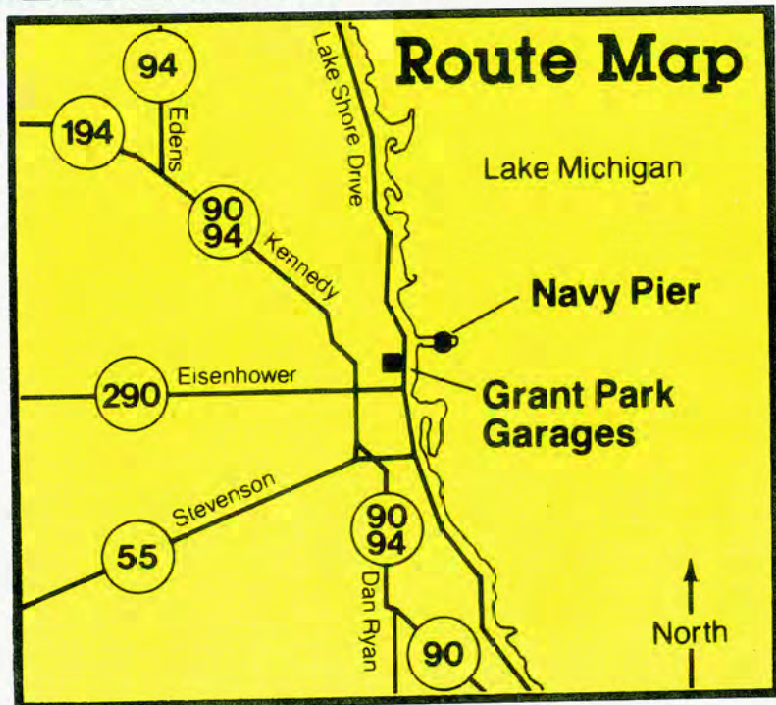
But there are alternate ways of getting there:
