Without a doubt, ChicagoFest is America's biggest and best Music Fest. For 12 consecutive days, from noon to midnight, 14 separate entertainment areas provide top entertainment in rock, jazz, blues, country, pop, folk, and comedy, too. A total of 50 different performances occur each day over Navy Pier's 40 acre area. And it's all available at one low admission price.

TICKETS

Admission to the entire festival is only \$6 at the gate, \$4 in advance; Senior Citizens, 62 and over \$1; children 10 and under 50¢ at the gate. Advance tickets, priced at only \$4 are being sold July 6-28 in the first floor lobby of City Hall, 121 N. LaSalle Street; at participating Chicagoland Chrysler-Plymouth Dealers; and at all Ticketron outlets including Chicago Sears and Ward's Stores. (Add 65¢ per ticket for handling at Ticketron). No ChicagoFest mail orders accepted.

HOW TO GET THERE

Warning: There is no parking whatsoever at Navy Pier. However, there is ample parking and public transportation provided as described below.

BY CAR: Soldier Field Lots: Free shuttle bus service to ChicagoFest from 11:30AM to 12:30AM every day EXCEPT Saturday, August 8, due to a Chicago Bears' game.

Grant Park Underground (Michigan Avenue): Free shuttle bus: 5:30PM to 12:30AM weekdays; 11:30AM to 12:30AM weekends.

BY CTA: Extra service provided direct to ChicagoFest via Grand Avenue Route 65.

CTA Subway: Exit at either Grand & State or Grand & Milwaukee and transfer to Route 65.

CTA Bus: Exit Grand Avenue on all Michigan Avenue N/S Routes, transfer to Route 65. Also direct service from loop on Route 15 Canal/Wacker, Mon-Fri until 7PM.

BY TRAIN: Free Shuttle Bus to and from all train stations, 5:30PM to 12:30AM weekdays; 11:30AM-12:30AM weekends.
